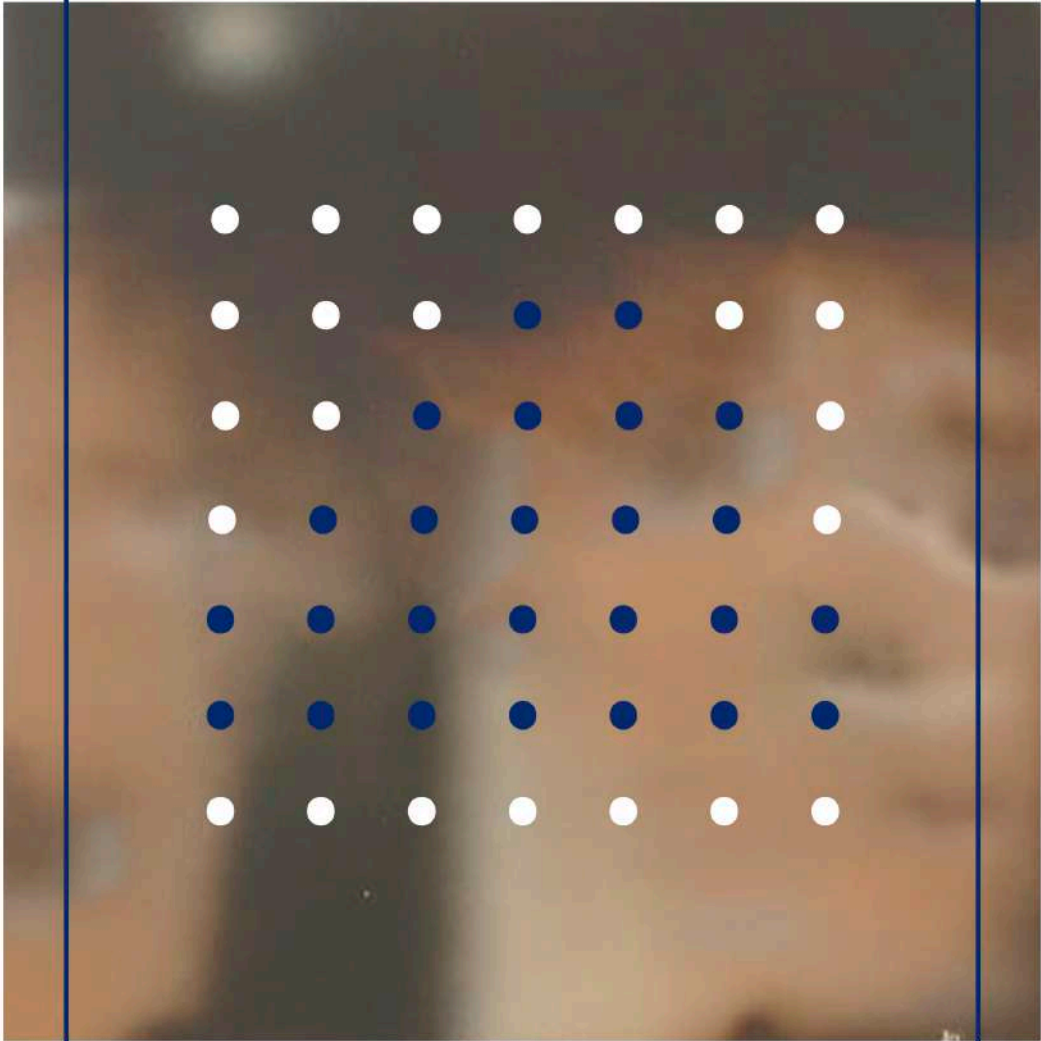

RESIDENCY AWARD AT
PIRAMIDÓN, CENTRE
D'ART CONTEMPORANI,
BARCELONA.**

Piramidón Centre of Contemporary Art is delighted to announce the launch of the First Jordi Fulla Artistic Residency Award, designed for visual artists interested in exploring and advancing their creative practices within Barcelona's vibrant artistic milieu. Named in honor of artist Jordi Fulla (Igualada 1967 - Igualada 2019), one of Piramidón's pioneering studio residents from 1991 to 2005, the award aims to celebrate his artistic legacy and unwavering creativity. Through this initiative, we pay tribute to his enduring influence and restless spirit.



• **ABOUT PIRAMIDÓN CENTRE D'ART CONTEMPORANI** •

Piramidón Centre of Contemporary Art is a distinctive hub that combines artistic production with the promotion, exhibition, and sale of artworks. With 18 studios hosting over 170 artists from 30 different nationalities, Piramidón serves as a vital meeting place where residents can cultivate their creative practices in an environment that nurtures creativity and encourages interactions within the contemporary art sector.

• **OBJECTIVES** •

The award aims to offer contemporary visual artists the opportunity to immerse themselves in Barcelona's artistic milieu. It provides the chance to work and reside in a studio, allowing artists to continue their artistic practice or explore new forms of creation. Additionally, participants will engage in various cultural activities aimed at enhancing their skills and fostering connections within both the local and international art communities.

• **DURATION OF THE RESIDENCY** •

The residency will last for 2 months, during which the selected artist will have access to a private studio at Piramidón Centre d'Art Contemporani.



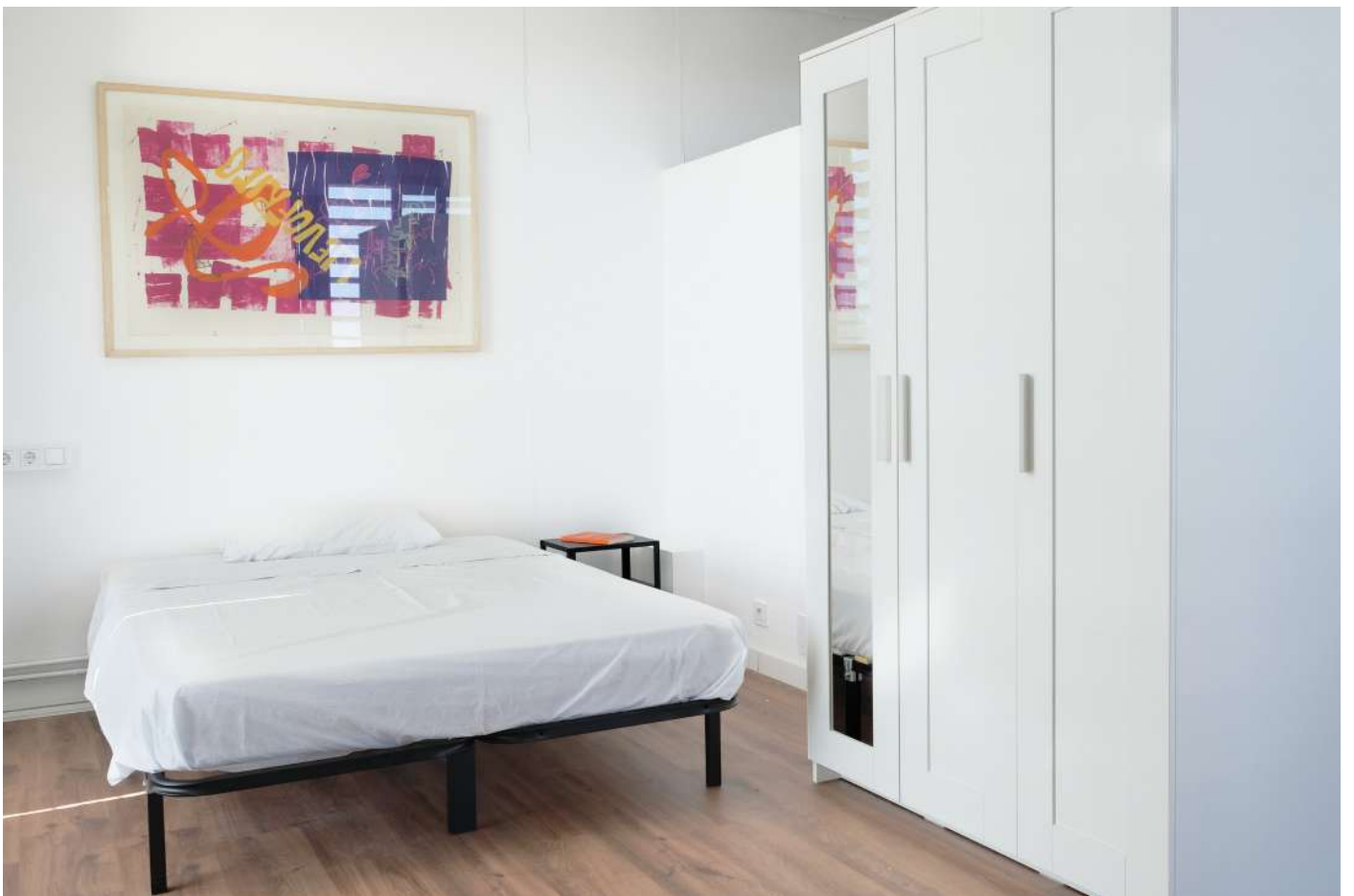


• BENEFITS •

Use of a private studio at Piramidón Centre d'Art Contemporani, ranging from 70 to 120 m², featuring ample natural light, stunning views of Barcelona, and 24/7 access. The studio includes a living space with a kitchen and dedicated workspace

- Up to €500 allocated for the purchase of materials for artistic production during the residency.
- Free access to the center's library, meeting room, and terrace.
- Access to tools and necessary machinery in the center's workshop, with technical support available.
- Participation in "paella-tertulia" and monthly gatherings with guests from the cultural and creative fields.
- Promotion of the artist's work and activities through the center's communication channels.
- Opportunity to participate in an exhibition at Piramidón's gallery, including an opening event and associated activities.
- Option to present an individual exhibition in the "Viewing Room" of the center.







• **ELIGIBILITY** •

The prize is open to visual artists of all nationalities and backgrounds.

Applicants must have held an individual exhibition at an art gallery or institution within the last three years.

• **ARTIST'S COMMITMENT** •

- Include in their Curriculum Vitae that they are the winner of the Jordi Fulla Residency Prize at Piramidón Centre d'Art Contemporani, specifying the dates of their residency period.
- Participate in a group exhibition at Piramidón's gallery.
- Donate one artwork created during the residency to Piramidón's collection, selected jointly by the artist and Piramidón.
- Cover their own travel expenses and living costs.



• **SELECTION PROCESS** •

Candidates will be evaluated by a jury composed of members from the Piramidón team and one of the resident artists.

Selection criteria will be based on the quality of the presented work, the potential for development during the residency, and the artist's ability to contribute to the creative environment of the center and the artistic community.

• **HOW TO APPLY** •

Applicants must submit a dossier including:

- Updated Curriculum Vitae.
- Portfolio of recent works.
- Proposal for the project to be developed during the residency at Piramidón Centre d'Art Contemporani.
